Saturday October 27<sup>th</sup> a meeting among artists, public, press agents will take place with the presence of Michael Attardi, Disney film director, together with some of the artists participating to the dubbing of his film "Once Upon a Christmas Village" (Amanda Davis and Tim Curry), the producer Dani Donadi, the dancer Raistalla (already well-known for her performances next to Madonna), the Australian singer Amanda Baker, Patrice Fivat (winner of the DigiFestival.net Sport category), the directors Peter Volkart, Enrique Garcia, Raquel Ajofrin, and the Video Art winner Cinzia Sarto. At the end of the DigiFestival.net Final Event Awards two concerts will take place: the Italian band The Mirrors will present a psychedelic rock/pop performance with influences from the 60es and 70es, followed by the New Yorkers Bohagey Bowes that with the images and videos of the director/musician Brian Hallas will lead us in an evening full of surprises, emotions, imaging, fun and... creativity!
